Most important characteristics	Acariquara is a type of wood with a typical appearance and natural wild shapes. Our Acariquara hardwood is FSC® certified.
Durability class	Most likely 1.
Applications	Horizontal railings, posts.

Colour	Acariquara hardwood has a light brown.
Details	The wood of the trunk is hard, has a density of 0.9 and hardly ever splits. Acariquara wood has a fine to moderately fine wood grain. This type of hardwood is extremely valuable. Not only for its durability because of its resistance to moisture and insect damage during the growth period, but also for its excellent ability to support heavy weights.
Grain	Cross wire, messy and irregular.
