The wood of the trunk is hard, has a density of 0.9 and hardly ever splits. Acariquara wood

has a fine to moderately fine wood grain. This type of hardwood is extremely valuable. Not only for its durability because and its resistance to moisture and insect damage during the

growth period, but also for its excellent ability to support heavy weights.

**Timber texture** Moderately fine. **Hardness** 9000-12000 N .
