

# Jutai

<b>Durability class</b>	Class 1-2.
<b>Specific gravity</b>	Freshly cut 950-1200 kg / m3. At 12% moisture content from 750 to 900 kg / m3.
<b>Colour</b>	Jutai wood has a dark reddish brown colour.
<b>Applications</b>	Jutai hardwood is suitable for furniture, <a href="#">floors</a> , <a href="#">facades</a> , panelling and is often used decoratively because of the beautiful veins.
<b>Grain</b>	Straight, sometimes irregular threads and light cross-thread.
<b>Timber texture</b>	Fine to moderately coarse.
<b>Stability</b>	Average.
<b>Drying</b>	Jutai wood dries slowly.
<b>Workability</b>	Fairly easy to work with and finish.
<b>Details</b>	This wood has a beautiful fine pattern.
<b>Screwing/nailing</b>	Pre-drilling is necessary for Jutai hardwood.
<b>Botanical name</b>	Martiodendron parviflorum
<b>Origin area</b>	Tropical Central America and South America.
<b>Background information</b>	This tropical wood is often confused with Jatoba hardwood.
