

## Jutai

**Durability class** Class 1-2.

**Applications**Jutai hardwood is suitable for furniture, floors, facades, panelling and is often used decoratively

because of the beautiful veins.

**Specific gravity** Freshly cut 950-1200 kg / m3. At 12% moisture content from 750 to 900 kg / m3.

**Colour**Jutai wood has a dark reddish brown colour. **Details**This wood has a beautiful fine pattern.

**Grain** Straight, sometimes irregular threads and light cross-thread.

**Timber texture** Fine to moderately coarse.

**Stability** Average.

**Drying** Jutai wood dries slowly.

**Workability** Fairly easy to work with and finish.

**Screwing/nailing** Pre-drilling is necessary for Jutai hardwood.

**Botanical name** Martiodendron parviflorum

**Origin area** Tropical Central America and South America.

**Background information** This tropical wood is often confused with Jatoba hardwood.
