

## Okan

**Durability class** class 1

Specific gravity Fresh 1000-1200 kg/m3. At 12% moisture content: 850-950 kg/m3.

Colour Yellowish brown.

Due to the great durability and volumetric mass (density), Okan can be used for outdoor work, such **Applications** 

as piles, civil engineering constructions (ground, road and hydraulic engineering), purlins, but also

for street furniture and decking.

Okan hardwood dries very slowly. The wood has a tendency to split and crack, although there is **Drying** 

almost no deformation.

The machinability of Okan wood is difficult due to the variable thread course and the high density. It Workability

has a blunting effect on most tools. For a smooth surface when planing, a cutting angle of 10

degrees is required. Okan can be used for woodturning and has a smooth finish.

A special feature of Okan wood is its smell. Okan has an unpleasant odour when wet. Once dried, the **Details** smell is gone. If you are looking for hardwood for your jetty or decking near a swimming pool, it is

advisable to choose a different type of hardwood. Okan hardwood is a very decorative type of wood.

Screwing/nailing Pre-drilling is necessary for Okan hardwood.

**Background information** 

Origin area Okan wood originates from Tropical West Africa. Other names Okan hardwood is also called Edoum or Denya.

The heartwood of Okan is yellow to golden brown with a more or less light to dark olive green hue,

which becomes reddish brown under the influence of sunlight. It sometimes has a deep coppery glow. The broad growth ring boundaries are clearly recognizable on the end due to the dark colour. The sapwood is light pinkish and 50-75 mm wide with a clear colour difference between heartwood

and sapwood.
